- 22.8.7 County Councillor's Report Cllr Oppenheimer was unable to be present
- 22.8.8 District Councillor's Report Cllr Drew
 - a) Cllr Drew said that Cllr Oppenheimer had confirmed that he will be organising a further Parish Forum on Motorbike Noise and Nuisance as a follow up from the meeting held on Friday 25th June 2022
 - b) Compliance: EHDC's legal team are driving for a conclusion regarding the site adjacent to Quin Hay Farm
 - c) Bordean Road, Packwood Arts application. EHDC were considering whether to take this application to planning committee
 - d) Wind Turbine Proposals Cllr Drew reported that land in Privett had been offered: SDNP were not interested in the present proposal but potentially small proposals with full support of the community might be considered: he had been informed that any payback was between 3 and 10 years: Potentially there is a 3 year wait for the next opportunity to apply to the National Park: Recently, comments regarding the wind turbines had been negative.
- **22.8.9** To agree the cost £530 plus VAT for a replacement picnic table with benches for the Recreation Ground Mole Valley are unable to supply the picnic table
