Who are we? The South-East Access Team looks after all the RoW in our corner of Hampshire. We promote the safety & maintenance of RoW for your enjoyment.

Why volunteer? Spending a day outside in the countryside, with like-minded people learning new skills is a proven benefit to our physical and mental wellbeing.

What can I do? We have two different ways to get involved: Group Task Days: These are weekly events all over the South-East of Hampshire. Task days can vary from vegetation cut-backs, putting in gates, ditch crossings, re-surfacing paths and more!

Path Warden: This can be done in your own time and your own local area. You will need to attend our in-house training session to be equipped with the tools and knowledge to go out on rights of way and help us with reporting, surveys, small-scale vegetation clearance and waymarking.
